Coach's Report

Seniors

After being sneaky little Bayswater Strikers on the last day of the season to stay up last year we went in to the new season looking to improve. It was magnificent to see lots of new player's young and old join the club and fantastic to see us back to three senior men sides, which is where we need to always be. We had a nice pre-season with good numbers getting involved on the track and down at Moe.

We started the season in goal-scoring form, rolling basketcase club Dandenong City 4-0 followed by 3-3, 2-3, 3-3, 3-2 and 3-4 games. At this point we unfortunately were hit by key injuries and unavailability affecting five or so strong contributors as well as losing our training ground and the ability to adequately simulate full-pitch conditions. The lads went on a disappointing run with only one memorably gutsy 1-0 win at home in atrocious conditions versus the TOPSA upstarts punctuating six losses including the now infamous Dandenong City debacle and Seaford massacre.

This left us in another backs-against-the-wall situation with four games to go, in the relegation zone and needing multiple good results to survive the Premier League in 2016. Our catchup game against bottom-placed rival Croydon finally came around and we smashed them in the first half before surrendering a two goal lead. Chris Jaques rising to head home a 80-something minute winner from Spoon's coach was special. An encouraging performance despite a loss to eventual title winners Seaford was followed by a 1-1 draw versus Croydon which again left our fate to the last day of the season at home.

The equation was simple, win versus 5th placed Mornington while Dandenong City needed to lose at 11am that day. City's 3-0 loss handed us the opportunity while the boys played our best football of the year to get ahead 1-0 from a classy opposite foot finish from Ally McNair. As is the tradition, it was touch and go for most of the second half before Django secured the result in the 90th minute with a magnificent top corner effort from the left flank. A work of art.

At times we played fantastic football and with a full list available I have no doubt that we could/can take it up to any team in here. 31 players pulled on the senior

strip this season, which as I look at it shows that we have depth, as does the great results in the reserves this year.

I would like to thank the playing group for sticking at it, despite the poor conditions and non-ideal training circumstances. We had few discipline incidents to take care of and I had no confrontations with players which is credit to you guys enjoying yourselves at the club. It has been a pleasure to coach you all this year and last year, and I am particularly excited about the new group of players coming on board this year. Stick together and we will have fun with each other for years to come.

I would like to thank Fang for her support and reminding me from time to time to lift, Brimmer and Murph for accepting all of my decisions which at times have disadvantaged their own sides and also how easy they have been to work with throughout. To my captains Chris Jaques and Mark Ellison and all of those who have stepped up on game day and during the year for training to lead the boys. Emlyn, you have done a great job with the girls this year and I have admired your organization particularly for training. The committee for backing me unreservedly and putting in all of the work that gets us all on the park. Keep up the good work, you are in safe hands led by Rook, thank you all. I encourage everyone to consider how you all can help out in your own ways next year to support them.

Finally, I look forward to next season and cannot wait to get amongst it at training and on game day with hopefully a clear injury run at it. It might be time to start converting those 'overs' into 'unders' and those 'passes to the keeper' into 'goals'.

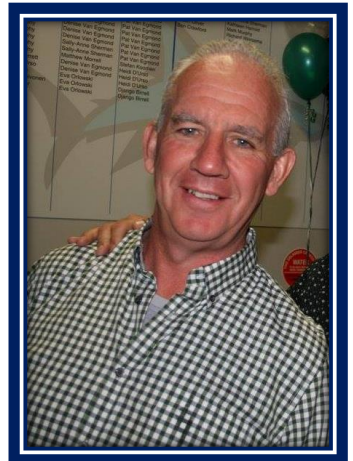
