## Coach's Report

### *Ladies*

After the heights of Season 2014, there was definitely optimism amongst the girls when preseason came around and that showed with great attendance throughout. We started our campaign at home this year against newcomers Frankston City and came away with a hard fought 4-2 victory. Over the subsequent weeks we started to hit our straps putting away plenty of goals, 35 in 4 games while our well organised defense was doing the job at the other end.

We then travelled to Rosebud and were lucky to come away with a win, down 1-0 at half time the girls showed plenty of character to grind out a 2-1 win with a late goal. Things didn't get any easier in the following round when we travelled to TOPSA, I knew that this game was going to be important come the end of the season with them being our closest rivals. After birthday celebrations the night before the girls weren't in great shape but pulled themselves together and managed a 3-1 win, including an exceptional goal from Marg who returned a goal kick with interest over the keepers head and into the back of the net. We were exactly where we wanted to become the halfway mark of the season.

The extended Cup competition meant we played Hampton Park and Rosebud, home and away, to advance to the semi-finals. We managed to win all 4 of our group games to qualify top in our group. The second half of the year saw more great results and although we had extended periods with no games, the girls managed to maintain their momentum playing some really great football. A tricky away trip to MCSC where we dropped points last year was again a very difficult game, but as they had all year never gave up to record a solid 2-0 win.

Coming into the Rosebud game at home we knew a win would be enough to secure back to back Championships with TOPSA being held to a draw a few weeks earlier. The game was played on our terms, as it had been for most of the year, as we always looked dangerous going forward and never looked like conceding when we lost possession. 3-0 was the final result and with that the pressure was lifted going into the last round. We still had plenty to play for with a perfect season up for grabs. TOPSA again pushed the girls all the way but we managed to hold on for a heart stopping 3-2 win.

The only downside to a magnificent season was our early cup exit against Frankston City, after creating multiple chances in normal and extra time and a stand out performance from the Frankston keeper, we went down in penalties. This however was only a minor blemish on a magic year, very well deserved with great attendance at training all season and working extremely hard on match days.

I would like to express my gratitude to all the volunteers who help out every week to make it possible to get out on the pitch, the linesman, marshal's, canteen helpers and most of all the committee for all their hard work.

# Coach's Report

## *Seniors*

Hitting round one, a stripped-down, unified playing group approached the new structure of the league willing to take on the huge challenges ahead. Along with on-field expectations to scrap and battle for as many points as we could, it was vital that the club hold its head up high off the field, sticking together regardless of what was happening on the pitch in a season of transition.

Chris Jaques accepted the captaincy with young Mark Ellison as vice and we jumped straight into it with a few new faces in the seniors as well as quite a few 'seasoned' players asked to step up. External expectations did not look on us favorably but the lads took on the league early earning credible results (4-4 Frankston City, 2-1 Mornington, 3-4 Boronia, 2-2 Seaford, 3-3 Croydon) which could have easily returned a bit more from each game. This would come back to us later in the season, although this did establish in the groups mind that when we were willing to put the effort in, we could achieve on the park.

We comfortably progressed in the new extended cup and recorded a memorable win on penalties in the Inter-Association Champions League v Churches leaders St Hilda's on a 'windy Wednesday in Kew'. A few significant injuries were attained in this period resulting in Mark Ellison to assume captaincy in Jaques' absence.

Mark was a model leader in his dedication to training and match-day after his trundle through Europe and really stepped up with his performances in a difficult midfield slot.

A poor middle period coinciding with poor weather and dwindling training numbers to an extent saw us fall away in the league. After a big loss to rivals Croydon we found ourselves on the bottom of the table.

A gallant loss to Frankston showed signs of improvement, as did another close defeat v Rosebud. Fortune had smiled on us that we still had managed to come down to the last game with a hope of survival. A win versus rival TOPSA and a loss for Croydon would keep us up.

Boronia did the right thing by rolling Croydon. Tick. We probed for an opening and finally got a chance when an impetuous defender did what most of us want to do a lot of the time and booted Emlyn up in the air to give us a penalty. Emlyn graciously passed the responsibility to Django who converted the important spot-kick. The next 50 minutes would be tense, with both teams hitting the cross bar and Rick coming up big for Baysie a few times. The final whistle sounded. We had escaped.

It was fantastic to survive against the odds. Well done to all who stepped up into a tough grade and put their bodies on the line. I would like to thank the committee for backing me in, the players for supporting me through my coaching and injury and poor Fang for having to deal with me on a daily basis. Congratulations to the girls for your amazing league season, I trust you will be back hungry to go one better after your early exit from the cup.

No matter who is in charge or what the coaching structure is next year we need to stay together in 2016. Let's push to greater heights next year by:

- Committing to pre-season to improve fitness, skills and overall game-plan
- Encouraging our friends to come down and share our club with us
- Train hard regularly throughout the whole season
- Give everything on the field for our mates and ourselves and get results
- Continue to enjoy the unique and amazing club vibe here at Bayswater Strikers

I am most pleased by the attitude of the members of the club this season. It would have been easy to throw the towel in on-field. It would have been easy to give up on training. It would have been easy to fight amongst ourselves when it wasn't going well. It would have been easy to stop supporting the club because we weren't winning. We did not do that, and that is why this club is great.
